Of the Candidates Who Were Granted an Interview for Our Program:

Nearly all past candidates who were granted an interview for our program met the following recommendations:

- Experience in a clinical hospital laboratory or clinical reference laboratory setting
- Academic achievement with an overall GPA, and a core course GPA, of at least 3.1
- Completion of "Core Courses" with a minimum letter grade of 'B' or higher
- Completion of all core courses within seven (7) years prior to application
- Completion of additional related coursework such areas Organic Chemistry and Physics, and to less frequent extent courses in Molecular Biology, Genetics, Mycology, Virology, Parasitology, Human Anatomy/Physiology, Phlebotomy, etc.
- Completion of lab courses or actual clinical laboratory experience in Hematology, Immunology, Medical Microbiology, and Analytical or Clinical Chemistry
- Completion of a college level or medical mathematics course such as Calculus, Statistics, Biostatistics, etc.
- Residence in, or near, the greater San Diego region (within 80 miles to central San Diego)
